CPR certification

CPR certification is a pre-requisite of all WFA courses. If you have a current CPR certification, good for 1 full year from the date of your WFA course, please provide a photocopy along with your registration forms. If you do not have a current certification you must register for the CPR course on the first evening of your WFA course. No WFA certification will be issued without current CPR certification.

What to expect at the course

The course is a combination of classroom lecture, indoor skills practice and outdoor scenarios.

Evaluation

Evaluation will be ongoing throughout the course and will include skill demonstrations, scenarios and a multiple choice exam.

You will be expected to take notes to maximize your learning during lectures and participate in scenarios.

What to wear

The program includes both indoor sessions and outdoor scenarios. You are advised to bring comfortable clothing for the indoor sessions and appropriate attire for outdoor activities (rain or shine). During scenarios we will be using stage make-up and clothes may get dirty.

What to bring for course and scenarios

Therm-a-rest style or ensolite pad (blue foam mat)
Small tarp or ground sheet (4X6)
Water bottle
Day-pack
Sleeping bag
Watch
